

Alexander Robinson 1996 Summer Fellows Program Fund

Deadline: March 21, 2025

The Alexander Robinson 1996 Summer Fellows Program Fund was created to encourage students of the College who have completed their first, second, or third year (rising sophomores, juniors, and seniors) to engage in an off-campus summer, career-related work or research experience (preferably of eight to ten weeks) within the United States or its territories related to a field of their choice. The Fund fosters hands-on education and experience. The intent is to provide stipends for summer work experiences for which students might not otherwise receive the funding that their financial commitments require. Each year the College secures partnerships for this and/or other, similar internship programs. The College targets its efforts to develop internships with College alumni and others interested in engaging bright, motivated students of the College. Students may apply to, and seek funding for, internships with College partners or with other organizations as self-designed internships to which they have applied or have secured. In an effort to fund more students during their experience at the College, students are only permitted to receive a grant from this Fund one time. Recipients do not need to demonstrate financial need, though preference will be given to those for whom the summer experience would not be possible without such support. The Fund will not provide funding for any programs with a participation fee.

Students should submit the following by Friday, March 21, 2025:

1. You will upload #2, #3, and #4 in the online form.
2. An essay no longer than 2 pages outlining your past relevant experiences and the purpose of the proposed internship
3. A resume
4. A signed letter or email confirmation from the organization with whom you will be working
