## **Jaharis Primary Care Pre-Med Internship Fund**

Deadline: March 21, 2025

The Jaharis Primary Care Pre-Medical Internship Fund was established by Steven M. Jaharis '82 in 2000 to provide summer stipends to pre-health students interested in delivery of primary health care through medicine, public and community health, and health policy social justice opportunities. The goal is to provide summer funding that will allow students to better understand issues that impact patients' primary care health needs in today's complex health care delivery systems.

This Internship Fund is open to first-year, sophomore and junior students at Haverford College. To apply to this self-designed internship fund, you must identify your own clinical setting and mentor. The funding must be used for a direct primary care or health-related experience with a supervisor and specified start/end dates. The Fund cannot be used for tuition for medical certifications or other types of training programs.

If you are currently in the interview process for a summer internship and do not yet have an offer letter, you are still welcome to apply. If you are awarded funding before your internship is finalized, it will be held until a date selected by the committee, allowing you to complete the application process. However, we will only be able to hold the award for an extended period of time before considering any waitlisted candidates.

Please apply by completing the online form by **March 21, 2025**, where you will be asked to upload the following three documents in one combined PDF document:

- 1. A 1-2 page double spaced essay or cover letter outlining your past relevant experiences and the purpose of the proposed internship
- 2. A current resume.
- 3. A brief, signed letter on letterhead from your supervisor outlining your internship responsibilities. This letter should confirm your hours per week and the full duration of the summer internship.
