Liberal Arts in the Workplace Grant

The Center for Career and Professional Advising (CCPA) administers the **Liberal Arts in the Workplace Grant** for Haverford College. Through this internship fund, CCPA and the College provide students support for internships to students with demonstrated financial need. The experience strengthens and develops the students' skills background. This internship enriches, integrates, complements and applies their classroom learning experience, and serves as a connection between the classroom and off-campus learning environments. The student identifies the host organization where the internship will take place and will gain direct experience to complement their coursework. This fund is open to rising sophomores, juniors, and seniors, and all academic disciplines are considered.

Each internship experience must be full-time (at least 30 hours per week), no less than 8 weeks long, and written confirmation from the host organization must be submitted before funds can be granted. The internship may be domestic or international (CCPA, and the College adheres to all relevant/current U.S. State Department travel warnings) The work can be done in-person, remotely, or as a hybrid experience.

Submit the following by March 21, 2025:

- 1. Online Application Form. You will upload #2, #3, and #4 to the online form
- 2. An essay or cover letter no longer than 2 pages outlining your past experiences, your interests, and the purpose of the proposed internship
- 3. Resume
- 4. A signed letter or email confirmation from the organization with whom you will be working
