THE WHITEHEAD INTERNSHIP PROGRAM SUMMER 2025

Partner Deadline: January 26, 2025 Self-Design Deadline: March 21, 2025

The Whitehead Internship Program was created by a Haverford alumnus, in honor of John C. Whitehead '43, to encourage Haverford students who have *completed their freshman, sophomore or junior year* (rising sophomores, juniors and rising seniors), to engage in an 8-10 week summer work experience related to entrepreneurial endeavors, small business enterprise, venture capital or investment finance activities. The intent is to provide stipends for summer work experiences for which students might not otherwise receive the funding that their financial commitments require.

Each year the College secures partnerships specifically for this program. The College targets its efforts to develop internships with Haverford alumni and others interested in engaging bright motivated Haverford students.

Students may apply to, and seek funding for, internships with "College Partners" OR with other organizations as "Self-design Internships," to which they have applied or have secured, which relate to the focus of the Whitehead program.

In an effort to fund more students during their Haverford experience, students are only permitted to receive Whitehead Internship Program funds one time. (For example, students who received a Whitehead internship after their Sophomore year are not permitted to apply to the program a second time.)

Financial Information for both Partner and Self-Designed Interns

All full-time Whitehead Interns will receive a \$6000 stipend for an 8 – 10 week summer work experience Whitehead Interns who will be working in-person in either NYC or San Francisco (partner or self-designed) may apply for additional housing funds online. All other area housing expense requests must first be submitted in writing to dadair@haverford.edu before being considered.

Partner interviews take place. There is no set requirement – partners will contact students directly and will interview by phone or Zoom.

First day that internship offers may begin from partners.

Week of March 7, 2025:

Target date for all offers made/accepted from Whitehead partners and students.

WHITEHEAD APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES

All steps must be completed by the January 26, 2025 deadline.

Review all Whitehead Partners and internship options through Handshake:

- 1. Go to the Handshake homepage and click on "Jobs"
- 2. Keyword Filter: "Whitehead Internship Program"
- 3. Use the official link to the Common Application Form and apply to each Partner Internship, separately, for which you wish to be considered.
- 4. Apply with these documents bundled into **one** PDF, in this order:
 - resume
 - one-to-two page double spaced statement of interest outlining your interests, related
 experience, your motivation for engaging in a business-related experience, and your anticipated
 career direction. Tip: You only need to write one essay. This is not a unique essay for each
 partner.
