The Future-Ready Ford Success Plan



The Future-Ready Ford Success Plan is a step-by-step interactive plan in Moodle designed to cultivate the five key Haverford-Specific career competencies: Self-Awareness, Communication, Professional Identity, Multicultural Proficiency, and Career Management. Students can engage in structured career and professional development activities called "career actions" and proactively use the plan to set themselves up for long-term career success. CCPA resources are embedded into the plan.

Aesop Academy

A virtual skills-based academy focused on mentoring and training students to develop the technical and professional skills in demand for modern-day organizations.

Big Interview

An online tool that offers recorded, virtual practice interviews to prepare for internships, full-time careers, and graduate school admissions. It also uses AI to offer tailored feedback for practice and resumes.

Campus Recruiting Program

The program features organizations who work with Haverford, Bryn Mawr, and Swarthmore from sharing opportunities to actively recruiting students at events and career fairs. Many organizations partner to post positions and offer interviews to prospective candidates.

Fellowship Advising

Our Director of Fellowships supports students and alumni applying for fellowships requiring institutional endorsement, including the Fulbright, Watson, Truman, and Goldwater.

Focus 2

A platform designed to help guide students through the steps of the career planning process. It offers various self-assessments that can be utilized to discover majors and career pathways based on individual interests, values, skills, and personality traits. Focus 2 also offers insights into various careers that includes suggested educational background, job duties, salary and growth prospects.
